Application Requirements



Grade	7	&	8

This test is used to gauge readiness for the Saint John's curriculum. Saint John's uses the EDSeries (Educational Development Series) for the Grade 7 test. It is a timed exam with five sections - three reading/language sections and two math sections. There is a \$50 testing fee.

Grade 9 Admissions Test

Saint John's utilizes the High School Placement Test (HSPT) to help guide decisions for intial ninth grade placement in addition to admission eligibility. There is a \$50 testing fee.

If your student takes the HSPT at a different school, please request that the score report be sent to Saint John's.

Application for Admission

All prospective students are required to complete the Application for Admission in Ravenna and pay the \$40 fee.

Student Statement

The student must complete this form in Ravenna in his own words. This allows the admissions team to learn more about the applicant and why he would like to attend Saint John's.

Parent Statement

The parent or guardian must complete this form in Ravenna in order to help us get to know your family better.

Official 2022-2023 & 2023-2024 School Transcripts

A parent or guardian must print and sign the Transcript Release Form in Ravenna and submit it to the applicant's current school. Saint John's requires grades from the last completed school year along with the most recent report card from the current academic year. Transfer students may initially submit self-reported grades; however, an official transcript must be received prior to attending Saint John's High School.



Recommendation

The recommendation may come from a current teacher, counselor, or school administrator who knows the applicant well. Enter their full name and email address in Ravenna and a secure, unique link will be emailed directly to them. This allows the person making the recommendation to submit the completed form online directly to Saint John's. Please note: only one recommendation is required.

Student Interview

A formal interview is required for all students applying to Saint John's. Once a student's application is complete, the Admissions Office will reach out to schedule the interview, which typically lasts a half-hour, and involves both the student and parent(s)/guardian(s).

Zoom Interview

(International applicants only)

The Admissions Office uses Zoom to conduct interviews with international applicants.

TOEFL Score

(International applicants only)

The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is a standardized test used to measure the language proficiency of international students. ETS should send the original TOEFL score report to the Admissions Office. The code for Saint John's High School is 7440.

Original Bank Statement

(International applicants only)

An original bank statement showing the equivalent of at least \$38,000 in U.S. funds must be submitted.

- Register for the Grade 7 Admissions Test on October 28 or December 9 / Grade 8 Admissions Test on December 9 and pay the \$50 testing fee.
- 3 Complete the Application for Admission in Ravenna and pay the \$40 fee online.
- 4 Complete and submit the Student Statement in Ravenna.
- 5 Complete and submit the Parent Statement in Ravenna.
- 6 Print and sign the Transcript Release Form in Ravenna and submit it to the registrar at your current school.
- 7 Choose at least one teacher, counselor, or school administrator to complete a recommendation on your behalf and enter their contact information in Ravenna.
- 8 Submit all application requirements, including the financial aid application, if applicable, by December 15, 2023. If the deadline has passed, please contact the Admissions Office to verify we are still accepting new applications.
- 9 The Admissions Office will contact applicants to schedule an interview once all other application steps have been completed.
- 10 Admission decisions will be mailed to applicants in late February 2024.

GRADE 9 APPLICANTS

- 1 Create a Ravenna account at <u>ravenna-hub.com/login</u>. Select Saint John's High School from the School Directory and choose 9th Grade Application Process.
- Register for the Grade 9 Admissions Test on October 28 or December 9 and pay the \$50 testing fee. Please contact the Admissions Office if you are unable to take the test on these dates.
- 3 Complete the Application for Admission in Ravenna and pay the \$40 fee online.
- 4 Complete and submit the Student Statement in Ravenna.
- 5 Complete and submit the Parent Statement in Ravenna.
- 6 Print and sign the Transcript Release Form in Ravenna and submit it to the registrar at your current school.
- 7 Choose at least one teacher, counselor, or school administrator to complete a recommendation on your behalf and enter their contact information in Ravenna.

Admissions Process

GRADE 10 AND 11 TRANSFER APPLICANTS


- 1 Contact the Admissions Office at <u>admissions@stjohnshigh.org</u> to inquire about a potential transfer to Saint John's.
- 2 Create a Ravenna account at <u>ravenna-hub.com/login</u>. Select Saint John's High School from the School Directory and choose Transfer Student Application Process.
- 3 Complete the Application for Admission in Ravenna and pay the \$40 fee online.
- 4 Complete and submit the Student Statement in Ravenna.
- 5 Complete and submit the Parent Statement in Ravenna.
- 6 Print and sign the Transcript Release Form in Ravenna and submit it to the registrar at your current school.
- 7 Choose at least one teacher, counselor, or school administrator to complete a recommendation on your behalf and enter their contact information in Rayenna.
- 8 The Admissions Office will contact applicants to schedule an interview once all other application steps have been completed.
- 9 An admission decision will be mailed to your home address after all required application steps have been completed.
- 10 Once an admission decision has been made, a meeting with the Assistant Principal of Academics will be scheduled to discuss appropriate level placement and class schedule.
- 11 Accept the enrollment contract and pay the initial \$500 deposit online.
- 12 Families will receive an email invitation from Blackbaud Tuition Management to create an online account to manage tuition payments.
- 13 The first Saint John's tuition payment is due in June 2024.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

- Applicants must be represented by an agency, such as BGE, IVY, or AIEP as Saint John's does not arrange homestays. The agency should contact the Admissions Office at Saint John's to determine if we are still accepting applications for international students.
- Request that ETS send the original TOEFL institutional score report to Saint John's using code 7440.
- 4 Create a Ravenna account at <u>ravenna-hub.com/login</u>. Select Saint John's High School from the School Directory and choose International Student Application Process.
- 5 Complete the Application for Admission in Ravenna and pay the \$40 fee online.
- 6 Complete and submit the Student Statement in Ravenna.
- 7 Complete and submit the Parent Statement in Ravenna.
- 8 Print and sign the Transcript Release Form in Ravenna and submit it to the registrar at your current school.
- 9 Choose at least one teacher, counselor or school administrator to complete a recommendation on your behalf and enter their contact information in Ravenna.
- 10 Schedule an interview with a member of the Admissions team via Zoom once all other application steps have been completed.
- 11 The enrollment contract and applicable international fees will be coordinated through the applicant's agency.
- 12 Saint John's must receive the deposit, original bank statement, and I-20 application before issuing a student's I-20. The I-20 is a document issued to accepted international students that indicates their primary purpose for coming to the United States is to attend school.
